Minutes of the Governing Board Meeting held Monday, Monday, February 22, 2016 at 10:00 a.m.

The meeting was held in the Founders Room of the Alachua County Library District Headquarters Library, University Ave. Gainesville, FL

 The 4Square refund from the return of the Xerox ColorQube printer shall be put back in the budget under Equipment for the use of Levy County, for whose benefit the purchase originally was made.
